Listed below is a summary of the requirements graduate students must complete to a earn master's degree at Wright State University.

1. Complete a Program of Study form.
2. Complete the requirements for the graduate degree within seven calendar years.
3. Achieve a cumulative grade point/hour ratio of at least a 3.0 in all courses taken for graduate credit (no more than six hours of 'C' are acceptable).
4. Transfer, non-degree and/or certificate hours may not exceed 50% of that required by the degree program.
5. Successfully complete the exit requirement.
6. Present one copy of an approved thesis (if required in the program).
7. Student must be registered for at least one hour of graduate credit as designated by the department during the semester in which the successful defense of the thesis is accomplished.
